Distinguished Members of Parliaments,

After the 13th congress of the Parliamentary Intelligence Security Forum (PISF) in Washington DC, we decided to organize the first French edition at the National Assembly with Congressman Robert Pittenger. This event took place in Paris on June 20th. More than 30 speakers were present including Interpol, European Council, Europol, Judiciary Police, Tracfin and foreign institution as the Argentinian Agency for the finance intelligence or the Embassy of Bahrein, afront of 300 people. This debate has been a real success, thanks to the quality of the exchanges and the precious guidelines of the PISF.

The presence of many reprensentatives and experts from different countries to share the experiencies and the good practices developed by the agences and the government, including also the new actors like the companies, NGOs and civil society has been appreciated. By creating this international network of intelligence, the PISF proposed a new international collaboration for the MP's.

Beside its quality of organisation, the Forum is a pioneer by proposing emerging subject as data and technology policy, new forms of terrorism, civil liberties and business intelligence.
